**ATF INVESTIGATES POSSIBLE FEDERAL FIREARMS VIOLATIONS
ASSOCIATED WITH THE DEATH OF 6-YEAR-OLD KAYLA ROLLAND
FROM MT. MORRIS TWP, MICHIGAN.**

The Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms (ATF) continues to assist the Mount Morris Township Police Department with their homicide investigation in the death of Kayla Renee Rolland. All Bureau resources have been offered to support their investigative efforts, to include the utilization of the ATF National Tracing Center. ATF Agents from the Flint Field Office, working with local detectives and police officers, are focusing their efforts on possible Federal firearms violations with regard to the 1103 West Julia Street residence as well as any possible adult offender(s) associated with that location. ATF will present all information of alleged Federal firearms violations to the United States Attorney's Office for their consideration of federal prosecution.
