**MARSHALLTOWN MAN
SENTENCED ON FEDERAL GUN CHARGE**

DES MOINES - On September 19, 2007, Kevin Jermaine Clark, age 21, of Marshalltown, Iowa, was sentenced to a term of 30 months imprisonment for possession of an unregistered firearm, announced United States Attorney Matthew G. Whitaker. United States District Judge James Gritzner also ordered Clark to serve a three year term of supervised release, and imposed a crime victim fund assessment of \$100.00.

On April 27, 2007, Clark entered a plea of guilty to the gun charge. At the time of his plea, Clark stipulated that on September 23, 2006, he possessed an unregistered firearm, that is, a sawed-off shotgun.

This case was prosecuted by the United States Attorneys Office for the Southern District of Iowa. This case was investigated by the Marshalltown, Iowa Police Department and the **U. S. Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives.**
