## Cameron Man Sentenced on Gun Charge

WHEELING, WEST VIRGINIA -- A 22 year old Cameron, West Virginia, man was sentenced on May 5, 2008, in United States District Court in Wheeling by Judge Frederick P. Stamp, Jr.

United States Attorney Sharon L. Potter announced that JOSEPH WILLIAM WOOD was sentenced to 36 months imprisonment to be followed by three years of supervised release, pursuant to an earlier entered plea of guilty. WOOD entered a plea of guilty on February 12, 2008, to one count of an Indictment charging WOOD, who had previously been convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence, with knowingly possessing a firearm on September 9, 2007, in Moundsville, which had been shipped in interstate commerce.

WOOD was remanded to the custody of the United States Marshal.

The case was investigated by the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms & Explosives, and the Moundsville Police Department. The case was prosecuted by Assistant United States Attorney Randolph J. Bernard.
