Police from the Mount Vernon District Station have recovered firearms that had been stolen during a burglary in March. On March 1, 2005, eighteen weapons, including shotguns and handguns, were stolen from a residence on Linton Lane in the Fort Hunt area. An investigation led police to Christopher Isani. On July 13 police, along with agents from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives (ATF), executed a search warrant on Isani's home and vehicle in the 1500 block of Baltimore Road in the Fort Hunt area. Seven of the stolen weapons were discovered during the search and four other weapons have also been recovered. Detectives are continuing the investigation.

Investigation also revealed that some of the firearms had already been sold to acquaintances of Isani. These individuals range in age from 17 to 23 years old. A sawed-off shotgun and handgun has been recovered from the home of a 17-year-old Fort Hunt area youth who was subsequently arrested and taken to the juvenile detention center charged with possession of a handgun and possession of marijuana. Another handgun has been recovered from an 18-year-old Fort Hunt-area man and charges are pending. All shotguns recovered had been sawed-off; serial numbers had been removed from many of the weapons.

Christopher Isani, 19, of 1502 Baltimore Road, has been charged with burglary in connection with the burglary in March and faces additional charges of robbery, use of a weapon during the commission of a felony and malicious wounding from an incident in July. He is currently being held without bond at the Fairfax County Adult Detention Center. The Fairfax County Police and ATF are continuing the investigation to recover the seven outstanding weapons and identify other persons involved.
